The advent of Bhagavan Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa ushered in the spiritual renaissance in India. Swami Vivekananda, the illustrious disciple of Sri Ramakrishna, gave the initial impetus to it by establishing the Ramakrishna Mission in 1897. The aim of Ramakrishna Mission is 'for the liberation of oneself and for the good of others'. The Mission is striving to realize its aim through its centers numbering over 171 in India and abroad.

Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda College occupies a place of prominence among the educational activities of the Mission. It was formally opened on 21st June 1946. To cope up with the demand for admission an Evening College offering various programmes under unaided pattern was opened in 1974.

The College, affiliated to the University of Madras, offers instruction in English Medium and admits only men students. The College has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council. The UGC granted Autonomy to the College from the academic year 2004-2005 for all the courses affiliated to the University of Madras.

The College has earned a name for itself in the field of higher education.

Computer and Science Laboratories:

The College has 4 computer laboratories (one for PG, two for computer science UG and one for commerce UG) and a microprocessor Lab, fully equipped with latest hardware with all accessories and licensed software.

The Bio-Chemistry major laboratory, Allied chemistry laboratory and Allied Zoology laboratory are all provided with modern equipments and infrastructural facilities.

Internet:

Internet facility is available exclusively for the use of students. It is free of charge.

Library:

The College Library houses a good number of latest books and current journals, which are available to students for reference and borrowing. A notable feature is that the Library is updated every year. A reading room is provided for the students to go through the daily newspapers, journals and business magazines. Presently the library is being computerized

Faculty:

The College has a dedicated faculty that is tuned to the definition given by Swami Vivekananda “the greatness of a teacher consists in the simplicity of the language, which is the most expressive”. Faculty members are well qualified and have experience in both academics and in industry. A good number of Chartered Accountants, Cost Accountants, Company Secretaries, Management Accountants and Lawyers are in the faculty list, which ensures a perfect blend of theory and practice in teaching. In addition to this, quite often guest Lectures are arranged by inviting experts from various fields to

present the latest trends in their subjects. There is a spacious, fully air-conditioned auditorium for this purpose, with multi-media projector.

Sports and Physical Education :

Students are encouraged to participate in games like Cricket, Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton, Carom and Chess. Exclusive facilities for indoor games and world standard Cricket ground are available within the college campus.

A gymnasium with state-of-the-art fitness equipments is provided for the use of the students, in line with Swami Vivekananda's advice to have “ muscles of iron and nerves of steel”. Students participate in the inter collegiate tournaments and win prizes and medals.

Extension Activities:

NCC, NSS, YRC and Rotaract are available to the students to join any one of them. NCC students participate in the Annual NCC inter-collegiate competition and perform well.

Viveka Studies:

'Viveka Studies' is offered as a course for the final year UG and PG students of the college under autonomous system. Weekly religion classes and the Viveka Study Circle are the forums through which the students are taught the Ramakrishna Vivekananda philosophy. An important feature of the college is the Friday Religion classes, in which students perform arati, chant Vedic hymns, sing bhajans and listen to talks on the life and teachings of Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi, Swami Vivekananda and Swami Ramakrishnanda.

Students also participate in the annual Swami Vivekananda Jayanti Celebration competitions where attractive prizes are offered to the participants.
