

- (d) In case of a delayed start, the number of overs to be bowled by both the teams will be reduced and accordingly the maximum overs to be bowled by the bowler would also be reduced.
- (e) The umpires are empowered to rearrange the number of overs to be bowled by each side in the event of delayed starting, or if play is suspended.
- (f) Not more than five fielders shall be employed on the inside throughout the match.
- (g) The laws of Cricket as enforced by the Board of control for Cricket in India and TNCA shall be applicable with the exception indicated above.
- (h) The decision of the umpires shall be final in all the matches.
- (i) Matches will be played on weekdays and weekends, unless the Committee decides otherwise.
- (j) All matches shall commence at 07.30 hrs and 12.30 hrs sharp at Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda College ground.
- (k) All matches shall be played on the dates fixed and request for postponement will not be entertained.

We are happy to inform you that we will be organizing Swami Vivekananda Inter-Collegiate Invitation Tournaments (9th Year) in the following disciplines:

- 1) Cricket (2) Tennis (Singles & Doubles ) (3) Table Tennis (Team Event)  
(4) Volley ball

We are glad to extend our cordial invitation to your esteemed institution to participate in the above tournaments.

#### THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE TOURNAMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS :

1. Participation in this Tournament will be by Invitation.
2. Only bonafides and regular students will be allowed to represent their respective Colleges.
3. The names of the players, along with the name of the Coach/Manager shall be duly certified by the Principal. It's compulsory. Then only teams will be allowed to participate in this Tournament.
4. Each college shall send one team in Cricket, Tennis, Table Tennis and Volley ball, but the hosts are entitled to field two teams in Cricket or in any other games.
5. The organizers have the right to reject any entry without assigning any reason.
6. Kindly mention ranked players to enable the organizers to give the seedings in the case of Tennis and Table Tennis.
7. The organizing committee's decision shall be final and binding in all matters.

#### TECHNICAL RULES

##### (A) CRICKET

- a) The matches will be played on 30 overs a side on knockout basis. A bowler can bowl a maximum of six overs. The semifinals and finals will be played on 45 overs basis in which a bowler can bowl a maximum of 10 overs. The hosts will supply cricket balls for the matches.
- b) Tied matches will be resolved as under :
  - i) The team having a higher run rate per over shall be declared the winner.
  - ii) If both teams are still in a tie, then the side losing fewer wickets shall be the winner.
  - iii) If the tie still persists, the side scoring more runs at the end of 10 overs shall be declared the winner in 30 over matches and 20 overs in 50 over matches.
  - iv) If still a tie persists, the same shall be resolved by the spin of a coin.
- © In case of abandonment of match due to rain or otherwise with first team having completed their innings and the second played at least 10/20 overs, the winner shall be decided as follows :
  - (i) If it is less than 10 overs, the winners will be decided by the spin of the coin.
  - (ii) At that state if the scoring rate of the second team exceeds the overall scoring rate of the first, they shall be declared winner.
